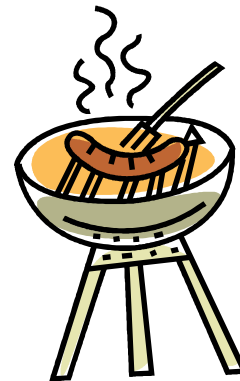

**\*\*\*DRESS CODE \*\*** - If you 'assist' your child into the arena by crossing the plain of the arena fence, step into the roping boxes, or help your child behind the bucking chutes you **MUST** be in dress code or your child will receive a No Time. If you step into the arena to volunteer your time by flagging an event, setting barrels or poles, or work the entry gate you **DO NOT** have to be in dress code. We need all the help we can get.

**CONCESSIONS** - The Kiwanas Club will be providing us with a concession stand from 8-3 each day. Breakfast and lunch will be served. Ice cream and cold drinks also available.

**VOLUNTEERS** - Many volunteers are needed to keep our day running smoothly and efficiently. We do not assign volunteers but rely on our parents to step in when called. You may need to flag, work the gate, set barrels/poles, time or announce. If your not sure how to help please ask.

**POLE DIRECTORS NEEDED-** a team of volunteers will ease the work load. Please step forward if you can fill this position. **NEED ASAP!**

**CHURCH SERVICE** –Josh Hand will be conducting Cowboy Church in the grandstands at 7am Sunday morning.

\*\*If you are interested in timing an event, or learning how to time, email me ASAP

with name and event interested in timing. I also need announcers.

**RIBBON ROPERS** – be sure you are familiar with rules.... Only boys enter, pay fees, and receive points & awards. Roper must find own female runner within own age group. Runner may be different each day but must be a rodeo contestant. Secretary doesn't need to be notified of who runner is but will notate it on timer sheets.

**Team Roping Draw** – All roping parents are now entered into the draw. Parents will be drawn in an age group they do not have a child roping in. I have done my best to recall if you head, heel, or do both. If I draw you in a position that you prefer not to rope be sure to let me know ASAP.

Buckles will be awarded to event champions at conclusion of timed events. All-Around awards will be awarded at the conclusion of rodeo. Winners need to remain in dress code for pictures. Please note that buckles are not awarded at every rodeo due to cost.

# Checks will be mailed.

**ONLINE ENTRIES-** If you entered online you **MUST** see me before noon on Sunday with your CC so I can process payment. Remember..... a \$10 processing fee is added to rodeo total for cc payments. Only enter online if paying via CC.

**\*\*\* Many of you still owe me \$\$\$ or forms. Be sure to settle up with me before Sunday afternoon.**

**Hats and Mugs will be available for \$20 at the membership dinner. Come check out the new designs for this season.**

To help with the close of each rodeo I will be asking some local families to stick around through the end of rodeo to help with clean up and take down.
